

## **- Tile Project Directions-**

### **Glaze Colors**

SC 12 – **Moody Blue** – dark blue  
SC 13 – **Grapel** – grape purple  
SC 26 – **Green Thumb** – grassy green  
SC 73 – **Candy Apple Red** – bright red  
SC 6 – **Sunkissed** - yellow  
SC 50 – **Orange Ya Happy** – orange  
SC 15 – **Tuxedo** - black  
SC 48 – **Camel Back** – light to medium brown  
SC 70 – **Pink A Dot** – pink  
SC 11 – **Blue Yonder** – sky blue

The success of this project really depends on you, the instructor. Please try to translate these simple instructions for your students and allow them adequate time to complete their artwork.

### **Directions for proper glaze application.....**

- **Make sure tile is free of dust or dirt ( you can wipe it with a cloth or a damp sponge)**
- **Apply smooth even coats for solid coverage**
- **Apply 1 coat for a translucent look**
- **Apply 3 coats for opaque coverage (3 thin coats are better than 2 thick ones)**
- **Colors are intermixable (but glazes don't mix like regular paints- yellow and blue won't necessarily make green)**
- **It is possible to get the glaze too thick! If this happens the glaze will crawl, which means the glaze will pull away from the tile leaving bare spots.**
- **A light pencil trace on the tile is okay for a painting guide. A thick pencil line will cause the glaze to crawl.**
- **Any tile area you wish to keep white, do not put any glaze on!**
- **The glazes should dry quickly due to the porous finish on the tile. Please allow each coat to dry before applying a new one.**
- **All glazes are non-toxic and can be cleaned with water.**

### **When Finished.....**

1. **Allow glaze to dry completely.**
2. **Make sure there is no glaze on the bottom of the tile or 1/8" up from the sides.**
3. **Carefully stack tile in a box, right side up, with layers of paper between them. The glaze decoration can be easily scraped off if handled roughly!**
4. **Take to designated area for pickup.**
